MRI preparation tool has been welcomed by paediatric and adult patients

Smileyscope’s newest product helps assess and prepare patients before magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) scans. These scans are important medical assessments but images can be degraded by movement, or worse, may need to be aborted if a patient cannot tolerate the MRI tube. We have successfully performed a beta rollout of this product. This VR simulation may help reduce the risk of aborted scans, or the need for costly sedation. One Senior

Medical Imaging Technologist remarked "It was very positive and we achieved a successful exam with the patient staying very still. The addition of the game/practice being still as well as the familiarisation of MRI noises was fantastic."
